

Circular walking route from Modbury Car Park



Battlefield Walk

Distance: 2¼ miles | Grade: Moderate | Time: 1¼ hours

Open fields with expansive views. Imagine the battle site with 8000 in conflict. Steep hill at start and finish. 5 stiles

- From Car park go back up to the main street via Poundwell Street.
- Turn left and cross the main road using the Zebra crossing
- Turn right and continue past the Co-operative store.
- Keep straight on up the steep hill (Galpin Street)
- At the very top near Traine Terrace a series of steps and stile on your right takes you onto FP7 (finger post)
- Bear diagonally across field to a stone stile
- At next field bear slightly right to another stile
- In this next field which is the site of the major battle in the Civil War bear diagonally right down to gate/stile in corner.
- Bear slightly left keeping hedge on your left, to stile.
- Turn right to a small gate and enclosed path.
- Follow this path to gate then sleeper bridge and metal gate.
- Cross field diagonally right to small metal gate and down steps into county road.
- Turn left and continue up to cross roads (Ayleston Cross)
- Turn left and continue along road to top of Galpin Street where houses begin.
- Continue downhill and after 100yds take FP2 (finger post) on your right to stile
- Down very steep field bearing slightly left and at bottom turn left to wooden gate (Mary Rose Gate) which brings you into the Millennium Meadow.
- Follow path to second wooden bridge and left into Fullers Ope. Continue back into the main street via Burns Lane.
- Turn right and go back to the Zebra crossing. Retrace your footsteps to the Car Park
